Join the Rockland County Task Force on Water Resources Management to gain an understanding of water systems and the water supply infrastructure in Rockland, and learn how to create and install water saving projects around your home or business. Projects to be studied include: rain gardens, rain barrels, disconnected downspouts, pervious pavement, drip irrigation, native plants and more. Students will also learn how to plant and maintain ecological landscapes which help conserve water, provide food and habitat for wildlife as well as increase the aesthetic beauty of a property.

This course is the first in a series, modeled after Westchester Community College's "Go Native U" program, adapted to promote water conservation efforts for Rockland County residents. Our course is comprised of 5 class sessions and 2 field-based sessions, and is instructed by Cornell Cooperative Rockland Educators. Class session on **May 19th** will **tour Suez water treatment facility and Lake De Forest Dam**.

Students can learn further hands-on principles during Part 2 of this course, offered in June-July 2016.

An **Information Session*** on the course is open to the public and scheduled for **March 8, 2016** at **Rockland Community College**; co-hosted by Rockland County Water Task Force and Rockland County Water Quality Committee.
